

CBLI STUDENT APPLICATION

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

*Join CBLI 2013 for Bible study, leadership training worship, and great times of relaxation and fun.
This is not a camp to come to if you are only interested in recreation activities.*

Registration Deadline – Monday, July 8, 2013

Registration may be closed earlier due to limited housing. Students will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis so send your application in as soon as possible.

Student's applications will be approved after the following documents have been completely filled out and submitted to THQ (no missing or incomplete information on any form)

- The CBLI Student Application Form
- Deposit and Payment
- Adventure Program Waiver
- Medical Form to include the immunization history MUST be filled out

CBLI APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Make sure a parent/guardian completes the entire application, signs it.
- Have your corps officer sign and date the application.
- Send the application to your divisional headquarters for approval (**DO NOT** send to THQ).
- There is room for 90 girls and 90 boys. Registration will be closed as soon as that number is reached. Sign up early in order to secure a space.

PAYMENT CHECKLIST

- \$25 non-refundable deposit is required to be sent with each registration.**
The remaining payment fee of \$195.00 is due by Monday, July 8, 2013 (\$25.00 (deposit) plus \$195.00 equals \$220.00 – the total cost for a CBLI student)

MEDICAL FORM CHECKLIST

- Use **ONLY CBLI 2013 Medical Forms**. For legal reasons only these forms are approved. These are **different** than the divisional camp forms.
- Give **ALL** requested information. The purpose of the medical form is to make sure we have necessary information, in case you need emergency care. Medical forms are carefully stored for your privacy/confidentiality.
- Give **complete immunization history (on the back of the medical form)**.
This is absolutely essential! We must make sure you have all necessary immunizations.

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- ❑ Bring all **prescription medications** to camp with you.
- ❑ **If you use an inhaler, be sure to bring it.**
- ❑ **Students with prescription medications, your doctor MUST complete the medication section.** Do not attach a copy of a written prescription or the label from a prescription. This information **MUST** be given by your doctor and signed by him/her.

RULES CHECKLIST

1. With the exception of scheduled free time, all campers are expected to attend all events on the daily schedule including meals, united sessions, Bible study, electives, peer groups, After Glow and devotions. Campers are to remain for the entire class/program period until dismissed.
2. The use of tobacco, alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are prohibited and will not be tolerated, nor will the possession of weapons of any kind.
3. Camper's automobiles are not to be driven in camp during CBLI. Camper's cars must be parked at the entrance parking area.
4. No camper under the age of 18 will be allowed to leave the campgrounds without permission of the TYS.
5. All campers are expected to handle basic cabin responsibilities with maturity by keeping personal belongings in neat order, making their bed and assisting with cabin cleaning assignments daily.
6. At curfew, 12:00 p.m., loud talking and loud noise disturbance need to cease.
7. Secular music is not to be played on the campgrounds.
8. After 7:00 p.m. each evening, campers are not to go beyond the road that divides the boys and girls cabins.
9. Campers will not enter any cabin other than their own.
10. No one is allowed in the cabin or on the porch of a cabin of the opposite sex at anytime.
11. Wonderland swimming pool policy dictates that discreet one piece bathing suits are to be worn (no bikinis for girls and no Speedos for boys) with an appropriate cover worn to and from the pool.
12. Theft, vandalism or destruction of property will not be tolerated. Cabins will be inspected prior to the arrival of the campers and at the conclusion of the camp. Any vandalism or damage to the cabin, equipment or surrounding area will be the financial responsibility of the campers housed within the cabin.
13. **I understand that CBLI is an electronic free zone:** Any cell phones and electronic equipment will be collected on the first day of camp. In case of emergency, parents may call the camp at 1-262-889-8905 ext 308. No cell phones will be allowed at CBLI period.

All campers are expected to abide by the CBLI rules. This demonstrates that **your priorities** agree with CBLI's spiritual and leadership purposes.

CONFIRMATION PROCEDURE

You will be confirmed as a student for CBLI ONLY when all your completed forms are received at Territorial Headquarters. You, your corps officer and your DYS will receive a confirmation e-mail from THQ.
