

## **Christmas Volunteer Opportunities**

**Bell Ringing:** Ring bells at different red kettle locations throughout the Fox Cities. Volunteers are needed from November through December. Volunteers are asked to sign up for a two-hour shift. Sign up begins middle of October.

**“Adopt-A-Family” & Toy Distribution Intake:** Assist staff and clients by reviewing applications for the programs. Volunteers will verify identification, income, and residence information provided by applicants. Volunteers will also be needed to answer and return phone calls from families and organizations who want to “adopt” families.

**Toy and Food Distribution:** Assist clients in picking up food and toys during Christmas distribution. Dates needed and sign up will be available in October.

**Toy Sorting:** Sort donated toys by age group. Volunteers are needed from November to December. There are two shifts available, 9:00am to noon and noon to 4:30pm. Some evenings and Saturdays may also be available. Dates and sign up will be available in October.

**Christmas Office Help:** During the busyness of the Christmas season, volunteers are needed to help with administrative tasks within the office of our Social Services Center. Volunteers are needed Monday to Friday, mornings and afternoons.
