



## Seasonal Opportunities

### **FEED THE KIDS**

'Feed the Kids' is a summer lunch program where lunches are assembled and delivered to children in greatest need in the Milwaukee area. Volunteers make the lunches weekday summer mornings for 10 weeks.

### **WISCONSIN STATE FAIR**

Volunteers meet the needs of the fair-goers by providing cold cups of water during all eleven days of the Wisconsin State Fair.

### **COATS FOR KIDS**

Volunteers are needed in October to help sort and process donated coats. Coats are professionally cleaned and provided to local children through our partnership with Milwaukee Public Schools.

### **TOY SHOP**

Hundreds of volunteers are needed in December to sort, stock and distribute over 100,000 toys for children in need over the holidays.

### **CHRISTMAS FAMILY FEAST**

Volunteers are needed December 23, 24 and Christmas Day for food service, set up, greeting and clean up. The Salvation Army, along with radio station 1290 WMCS, feeds more than 7,000 people annually at the Midwest Center.

### **PRISON TOY PROGRAM**

In November, volunteers are needed to wrap and ship over 5,000 Christmas gifts to children who have an incarcerated parent.

## Year Round Activities

### **MEANINGFUL MAKEOVERS**

This is a year-round on-going program for individuals or groups to remake a room at The Salvation Army Emergency Lodge. The cost for the makeover is raised by the group or individual. This is a great volunteer opportunity to make a difference in the lives of those most in need.

### **FOOD PANTRY**

There is a great need for volunteers at our year-round food pantry to assist with stocking shelves, intake work and assisting clients. The food pantry is open weekdays and is located at 1645 N. 25th Street.

### **EDUCATION CENTER VOLUNTEER**

Be a volunteer tutor for the children at The Salvation Army Emergency Lodge and Community Centers to help give them the extra one-on-one help they need to advance academically. Volunteers can also lead arts and crafts projects or teach choir and music.

### **RED KETTLE BELL RINGERS**

Volunteer with your family or organization to ring the bells during the holidays to help The Salvation Army raise money for our year-round programs.

### **LIFE SKILLS VOLUNTEER**

Volunteer to share your knowledge with individuals in Transitional Living, our Community Centers and the Emergency Lodge. Talents such as sewing, cooking, knitting, computer use and money management are welcome. Volunteers are needed to mentor and teach character building, GED preparation, ESL (English as a second Language) and U.S. citizenship classes.

### **GYM AND RECREATION**

Volunteers are needed at our Salvation Army Community Center locations to assist with basketball, volleyball and other gym activities.

A great group volunteer activity is to spearhead a collection drive at your workplace, church or organization for items such as food, mittens, toiletries, puzzles, toys, towels, and games for children and adults we serve.
