Social Services Department

The intent of The Salvation Army Social Service Department is to provide basic human necessities to members of this community regardless of race, color, creed, sex or age. Through supplying basic human necessities, we also intend to influence individuals by expressing God's love as we give in His name.

Through Social Services, The Salvation Army strives to give knowledge of all area resources to increase the likelihood of self-sufficiency in our clients. Educational classes are offered in each department and are often required in order to access services. We take a holistic approach to each person seeking help, by looking at reasons for the specific need and trying to address all areas where resources may be helpful, including spirituality. We collaborate with many area agencies in order to provide the most comprehensive and appropriate services to those in need without duplicating services.

Currently, we offer housing assistance, medical services through our free clinic, comprehensive services, and child care.

Housing Assistance

Available to all Sheboygan County Residents

Emergency Shelter

The Emergency Lodge, a 21 bed homeless shelter, located at 710 Pennsylvania Avenue, is available to those persons without the means to provide for their immediate housing. This program offers comprehensive case management services along with three meals a day and other items as needed. The shelter is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Transitional Living Program

Using the "housing first" model, the Transitional Living Program is for single individuals with mental health and/or addiction issues. Twelve month rent assistance and an additional six months of supportive services are available to those who qualify. Call for an application. Residency and income eligibility apply.

Housing Assistance

Designed as a homeless prevention program, services include financial assistance for rent and mortgage payments when funds are available, landlord/tenant mediation, educational components such as classes on landlord-tenant relations, and tenant rights. Households must be able to show financial need.

Red Shield Free Clinic

The Salvation Army Red Shield Free Clinic offers medical, dental, and optometry care to qualifying, uninsured Sheboygan County residents. It is staffed by local, volunteer, medical providers, nurses and support personnel.

The Red Shield Free Clinic offers short-term medical care and up to \$350 per year in needed prescription medications for low-income, uninsured individuals at no cost.

Specialty care is provided through the medical offices of cooperating Sheboygan County hospitals and physicians.

The Red Shield Free Clinic is open every Thursday and every second and fourth Monday from 6 pm to 9 pm. Two Thursday morning clinics are also available each month during the same weeks of the Monday clinic. The clinic is located at 710 Pennsylvania Avenue. Clients are treated on a first-come, first-served basis. Arriving early is recommended because a limited number of individuals are seen per session.

The Salvation Army, an International movement, is an evangelical part of the universal Christian church. Its message is based on the Bible. Its ministry is motivated by the love of God. Its mission is to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ and to meet human needs in His name without discrimination.

Comprehensive Services

Residents from Sheboygan, Sheboygan Falls, Kohler, and Howards Grove are eligible to apply for assistance by appointment Monday through Friday.

Services include: Food Pantry, Utility Assistance, Work Boot Vouchers, Clothing, WI ID Cards, Spiritual Counseling

Seasonal Assistance: Christmas toys, clothing and food, Coats for Kids Program, tax services.

Child Day Care

The Salvation Army Day Care Center, a licensed facility by the State of Wisconsin, located at 1125 N. 13th St. in Sheboygan, is available to children ages six weeks to 12 years old during the hours of 5:30 am to 6:30 pm, Monday through Friday. Before and after school programming is also available. Children learn from exploring through a creative curriculum model. Alternating activities between active and quiet, the staff give children the balance between structure and flexibility that they need.

The facility features an infant, toddler, preschool and school-age room with restrooms attached to each space. Nutritious meals and snacks are provided. All staff members meet the standards of the State of Wisconsin Licensing Board. Call the Day Care at 457-4162 for more information. The Day Care welcomes families of diverse socio-economic and cultural backgrounds.
