### Housing Assistance Center

In 2003, The Salvation Army became the operator of the Sheboygan Housing Assistance Center, a one-stop housing shop to better assist those with housing issues in Sheboygan County.

Services provided include financial assistance for rent and mortgage payments, when funds are available, along with landlord/tenant mediation. Educational components such as classes on landlord-tenant relations and tenant rights are also offered to better serve those in need.

To be eligible for assistance, one must be a Sheboygan County resident and in some cases be a City of Sheboygan resident. Additionally, the client must be able to show financial need.

## Emergency Lodge

The Emergency Lodge, or homeless shelter, is a 21 bed shelter that strives to meet the needs of those who find themselves homeless and without the means to provide for their immediate housing. In providing shelter, we work together to promote emotional, physical and spiritual wellness to the glory of God. The Emergency Lodge is open to families and individuals and is the only such shelter in the tri-county area.

### Intake Policy

The Emergency Lodge will admit up to 21 individuals on a first-come, first-served basis. It is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Intake may occur at anytime as there is always a staff member on duty. Initial eligibility for services are dependent upon the following criteria:

#### The individual must:

Be without permanent residency in Sheboygan County or temporarily without shelter.

Have no other accommodations for their situation.

Have no resources to meet immediate housing needs. If individuals have money on hand, a minimum of 75% of it must be secured with The Salvation Army to be returned when housing is available.

Have a valid picture I.D. If none is available, a police release is mandatory from the Sheboygan Police Department unless escorted by a law enforcement officer.

Not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Must be 18 years or older. Children must be accompanied by their legal guardians.

Sign a client profile agreeing to adhere to house rules as presented in the information pamphlet.

Exceptions to the above eligibility can only be granted by the Casework Supervisor, Director of Social Services or Commanding Officer.

### Winter Policy

The Salvation Army does not turn away homeless individuals during severe weather conditions. An overflow area is available if necessary.

## Red Shield Free Clinic

The Salvation Army Red Shield Free Clinic opened in 1992 to provide medical, dental, and optometry care to qualifying, uninsured Sheboygan County residents. It is staffed by local volunteer doctors, nurses and support personnel.

Discounted specialty care is provided in the medical offices of cooperating Sheboygan County physicians through a referral program. This is utilized to assist clients with medical needs that are beyond the scope of what the clinic can provide.

The Red Shield Free Clinic provides short-term medical care and up to \$350 per year in needed prescription medications for low-income, uninsured individuals at no cost.

### Qualification for Services

Family income must meet The Salvation Army requirements. Additionally, proof of no insurance coverage and residency information must be provided.

### Operating Hours

The Red Shield Free Clinic is open every Thursday and every second and fourth Monday from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Two Thursday morning clinics are also available each month during the same weeks at the Monday clinic. The clinic is located inside The Salvation Army Corps Building. Clients are treated on a first-come, first-served basis. Appointments are not necessary but arriving early is recommended as approximately 20 clients are seen per session.

### Dental Services

Limited dental care is provided through the Red Shield Free Clinic for children ages 2—12 and for adults. The program is aimed at providing dental care to families who are determined by The Salvation Army to be low-income, uninsured residents of Sheboygan County.

All services are provided at a dental facility by licensed professionals and are by appointment only, pending availability.

## Child Care & Youth Programs

### Salvation Army Day Care Center

The Salvation Army Day Care Center is located at 1125 N. 13th St. in Sheboygan. Care is available for children ages six weeks to 12 years old. The building features two infant rooms, a toddler room, a pre-school room and a school age room. A restroom is attached to each space. We also have a kitchen and provide nutritious meals that are made on-site. All staff members meet the standards of the State of Wisconsin Licensing Board. ### Youth Programs During the School Year

Programs are offered for children ages 6—18 at The Salvation Army Corps. During the school year children may attend after school character building programs featuring badge work and interactive learning. Programs that are offered include:

WAKIES— (Wednesday Activities for Kids in Elementary School) Children are picked up from their school for an evening of Sunbeams, Explorers, Singing Company, music, supper and more. Rides home are provided.

TNT—(Tuesday Night for Teens) Middle and high school teens are invited to participate in Girl Guards, Rangers, supper and the TOTAL program. TOTAL is a discussion and education group based on tough issues that face today's youth.

Corps Cadets — On Sunday afternoons, this leadership class teaches The Salvation Army version of confirmation or catechism.
