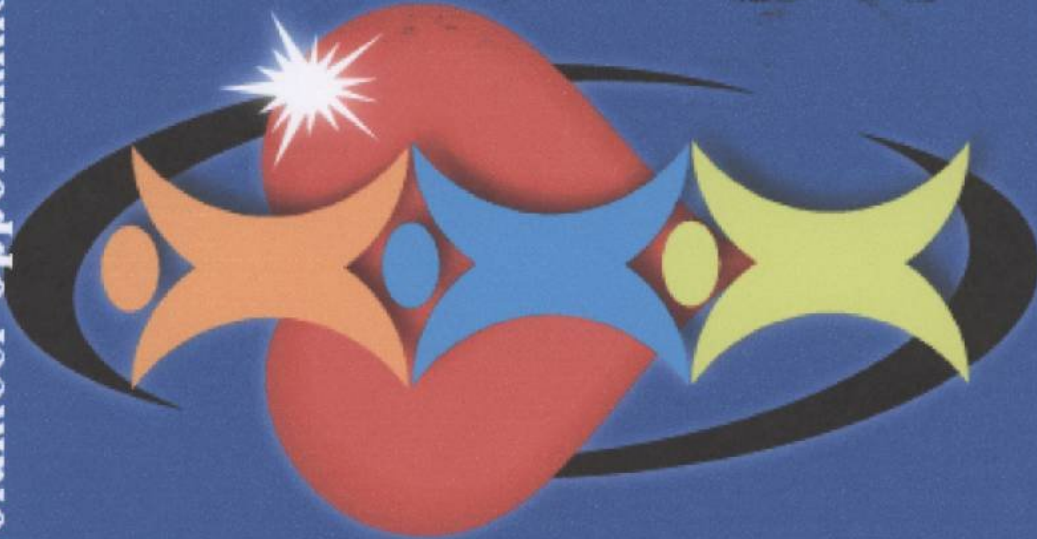

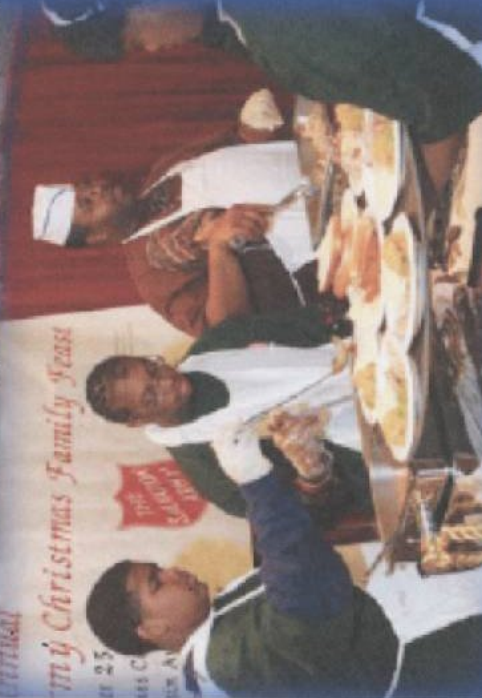

Seasonal Opportunities

Feed the Kids

Volunteers are needed to prepare lunches for the Feed the Kids program throughout the summer. This is a great family opportunity!

Bell Ringers

Individuals or groups are needed to ring bells at our many Waukesha County locations during the Christmas season.

Christmas Gift Distribution

Assist with sorting and packaging gifts for children and families; and the distribution of gifts. Spanish speaking translators are greatly needed.

Summer Camp Counselors

Adult volunteers are needed to plan arts and crafts activities for our summer camps.

Snack Pack:

Volunteers are needed to help pack and distribute backpacks full of food for students to take home on the weekends during the school year.

Housekeeping

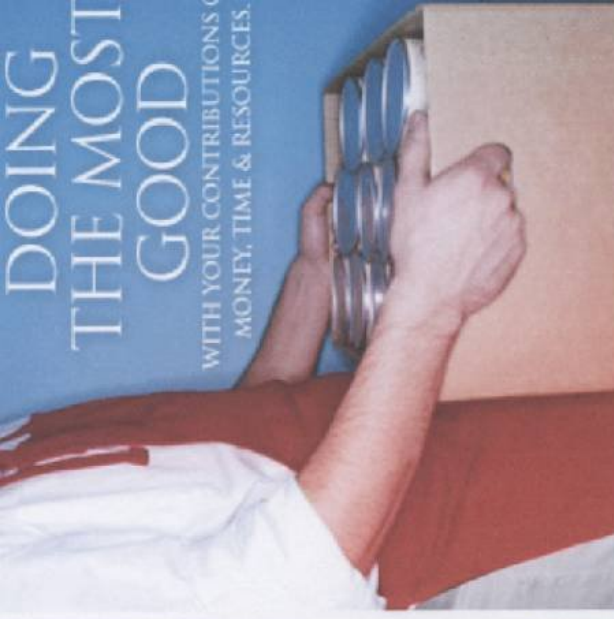
Volunteers are needed to help keep the facility clean, while learning marketable skills in the housekeeping and maintenance area.
